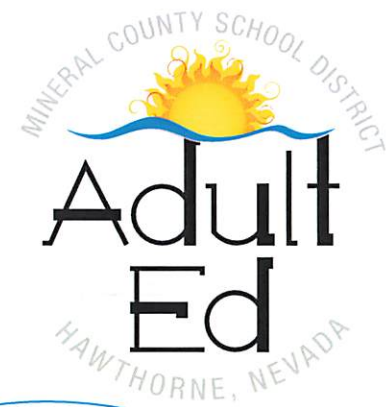

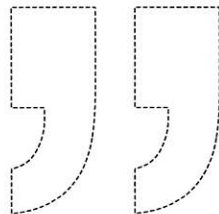
The mission of Nevada Adult Education is to provide lifelong educational opportunities that will assist in the development of individuals for meaningful, productive lives.

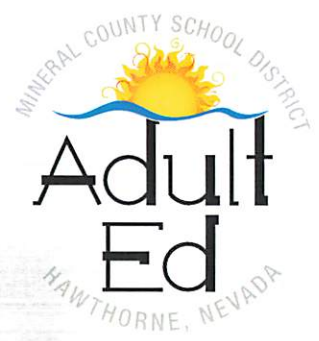


**ELIGIBILITY**

**Adult Education programs** are provided to out-of-school persons who desire to earn a high school diploma or HSE certificate. Such persons must be at least 17 years of age or older and have no intention of returning to a regular high school. (Refer to NAC 389.695)

**A student working** toward an Adult High School Diploma or HSE Certificate through Adult Education will not be assessed a tuition fee.

**Students in regular** attendance in an established high school who seek to make up deficient credits to stay on target for graduation in the high school they are attending must have written approval from their established high school principal, counselor, and parent or guardian to earn such credits and will be admitted on a seat available basis.



**MISSION**

The mission of Mineral County Adult Education is to provide a comfortable, confidential and flexible learning environment where adults of all ages can achieve the goal of earning a High School Equivalency certificate or an Adult Education diploma at their own pace.

**EARNING AN HSE CERTIFICATE**

- There are three recognized High School Equivalency (HSE) exams.
- HiSET (High School Equivalency Test)
  - TASC (Test Assessing Secondary Completion)
  - GED (General Educational Development)

**HiSET** (High School Equivalency Test) is the HSE exam offered at Mineral County Adult Education.
