- ESSER II Approved – December 30, 2021
- ESSER III Additional Allocation Made Available to District – December 15, 2021
- ESSER III Additional Allocation is \$425,043.00
- ESSER III Total Allotment is \$1,274,267.00
- Safe Return to In-Person Instruction Plan Revised by Nevada Department of Education. Ready for School Board Review in January.
- All ESSER Positions Posted as of 1/14/2022

Outcomes from Last Meeting

- Projects updated to include suggestions from Stakeholder’s meeting.
- Total suggestions to date number 138
- Conversations continue regarding ESSER/COVID in Leadership meetings, Cabinet meetings, Site Level staff meetings, Safety meetings, correspondence and one-to-one conversations.
- Spontaneous suggestions/ideas/requests still being received as mitigation measures continue.

Steps Forward

- ✚ Assure that current allocations are being tracked/spent.
- ✚ Concentrate on on-going recruitment for open positions.
- ✚ Develop funding priorities for additional allocation and grant revision.

- ❖ Following closely Legislative America’s Rescue Plan submittals that include building of new high school.
- ❖ Prioritizing and Reviewing Capital Projects allocations at the Board level.
- ❖ Categorizing purchases that are directly related to COVID i.e. masks, cleaning supplies, testing.
- ❖ Monitoring additional federal funding opportunities as they arise, i.e. eRate Emergency Broadband, Transportation funding, etc.
