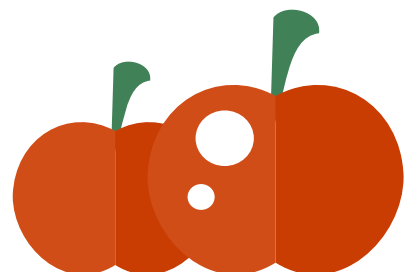
How to Use this Guide

STEP ONE

- Submit bachelor degree transcripts (use escrip.com or parchment.com or mail to PO Box 1626 Denton, Texas 76202)
- Get Accepted and Complete Letter of Agreement

STEP TWO - TRAINING

- Complete the introductory course 5000 & 5100
- Pass Praxis Core (Reading, Writing, Math)

STEP THREE - TEACHING

- Two Semester Residency as the Teacher of Record

STEP FOUR - RESIDENCY COMPLETED

- All coursework completed
- All testing passed
- Successful Residency

RESUME & INTERVIEW CHECKLIST

Choose a great resume template, don't have one? Get one at iteach.net/resume/

Objective Statement: Typically one sentence answering the question, "What are you wanting and why are you applying for this job?"

Education Section: Keep this section brief and only list what is necessary

Experience Section: This is the meat of your teacher resume

Community Service: Only include if it is relevant, but it is okay to leave off

Relevant Training Section: Do you have a certification needed for this job? Are you working towards a certification needed for this job? List it!

Check your resume for spelling and grammar. Have a friend review it if possible.

BE INTERVIEW READY

Familiarize yourself with the STAR Interview Method (Situation / Task / Action / Result)

Professional Attire. Clean, ironed clothes. Hair brushed. Men wear a tie.

Be confident, have an enthusiastic attitude and a willingness to try new things

Printed list of references (to provide if asked)

Copy of Certification held (or demonstration of eligibility)

Review a list of interview questions and be ready (iteach.net/resume/ has several)

PUNCTUALITY AND COMMUNICATION

When it comes to securing a job as a teacher, remember to be on time for your interview. Plan ahead for things such as traffic, parking, or anything that could delay your arrival time. As a final reminder, one of the most important soft skills that you need as an educator is communication. Be a good listener and show that you can communicate well with a variety of people.

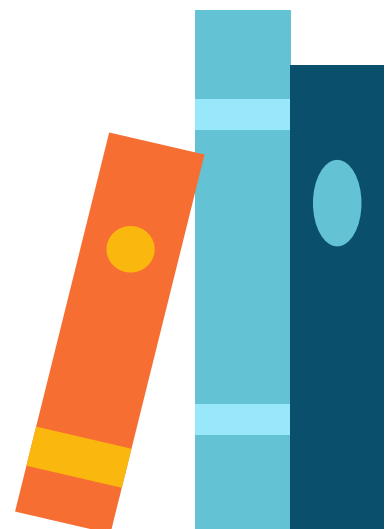
